April 3 The Deputy Commissioner of Finance approved the agreement to merge **COUNTRY CLUB BANK, N. A.**, Shawnee Mission, Johnson County, Kansas, with and into **NORBANK**, North Kansas City, Clay County, Missouri, Charter No. 1425 (the surviving bank), under the Articles of Agreement of **NORBANK**, with the main banking house of the surviving bank to be located at 414 Nichols Road, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. Since it was determined that aforesaid banks were wholly owned by the same bank holding company, the merger took effect immediately upon close of business on April 3, 2009. Pursuant to the agreement of merger, the surviving bank was issued a trust company charter under Charter No. 342 and renamed **COUNTRY CLUB BANK**.

The Deputy Commissioner of Finance issued a Restated Certificate of Incorporation and a certified copy of the Restated Articles of Agreement to **COUNTRY CLUB BANK**, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. The Restated Articles of Agreement supersede the original Articles of Agreement and all amendments thereto.

April 7 Certificate of Authority No. 1235-A issued to **INDEPENDENT FARMERS BANK**, Maysville, DeKalb County, Missouri, granting the bank permission to relocate its already established branch from 206 North Connecticut, King City, Gentry County, Missouri, to 451 North Connecticut, King City, Gentry County, Missouri.

April 10 Certificate of Authority No. 3381 issued to **CITIZEN'S BANK, AMSTERDAM, MO.**, Amsterdam, Bates County, Missouri, granting the bank permission to establish and maintain a separate branch at 19 South Orange Street, Butler, Bates County, Missouri.
